A new book ‘Connections: artists and writers in North Craven’ is being launched this week by the North Craven Building Preservation Trust. The 84-page book, with a Foreword by Bill Mitchell, enlarges on the theme of a highly-acclaimed exhibition held at The Folly in Settle last year and features artists and writers, past and present, who have been inspired by the magnificent landscape of North Craven. Four trails lead readers round the area to discover the many fascinating connections between people and places. The richly illustrated book also contains a biographical section and suggestions for further reading. The publication has been funded by Allan Gould and also through Defra’s Aggregates Levy Sustainability Fund, managed by the Yorkshire Dales Millennium Trust.
